Job Description: Jr. High Camp Director

Reports to: Program Director

Capacity: Temporary (non-exempt) position

Compensation: Pre-camp hours: June 22 - July 5 (2 weeks x 10 hrs/week x \$25/hr) = \$500.00
Summer camp: July 6 - July 25 (3 week x \$800/week) = \$2,400.00, plus room & meals.

Job Summary: Facilitates summer camp programming for high school-aged campers in collaboration with the Director team; helps with volunteer recruitment, training, and supervision of Sr. High Camp volunteer counselors; and helps with creating, planning, and leading volunteer and staff training.

Skills and Qualifications Ability to: Facilitate Jr.High school level programming that is focused on anti-racism, pro-LGBTQIA+, and consistent with the mission of Pilgrim Pines Camp; supervise and support volunteers; showcase knowledge and expertise in working with older youth; maintain focus on mission and organization program components; and promote social justice and anti-racist/bias mindset. Must be 18 years old or older.
