Skills and Qualifications: Ability to: create and facilitate arts and crafts programming that is mission-focused on anti-racism and pro-LGBTQIA+, consistent with the mission of Pilgrim Pines Camp; showcase knowledge and expertise in the fine arts; and maintain focus on mission and organization program components; and promote social justice and anti-racist/bias mindset.

Key Responsibilities

- Pre-Camp responsibilities:
 - Develop an arts and crafts curriculum for all age groups based on the summer camp daily and overall themes
 - Collaborate with age-level Directors to plan art/craft activity needs for programming, including potential interest groups
 - Create material lists and work with the Assistant Director to order supplies (within the camp budget)
- Camp responsibilities:
 - Lead or supervise all art/craft activities, including set up and clean up
 - Help with nighttime programming
 - Maintain weekly use inventory and collaborate with the Program Coordinator for any additional supplies needed through the summer
 - Maintain cleanliness and orderliness of the Craft Lodge and the craft supply area in the Tunnel
 - Help set up and take down the "all camp" activities
